Your responsibilities In order to achieve your Gold Award, you need to complete a minimum of 1 hour of volunteering time, per week for one year.)

- Act as a point of contact for your pool of up to six Bronze students
- Collect reports on a monthly basis from your mentees and send them to doe@turnthetideportishead.co.uk At the end of their three months you will need to gather information from your mentees to help us complete the assessors report (see below).

Record Keeping

You will need to keep a record of your litter picking activities, which should include:

- Date
- Time Spent
- Location
- Amount of rubbish and recycling collected e.g. ¼ bag rubbish and ⅓ bag of recycling
- Photographs if possible
- Plus a record of any activity involving your Bronze students ie time spent etc.
